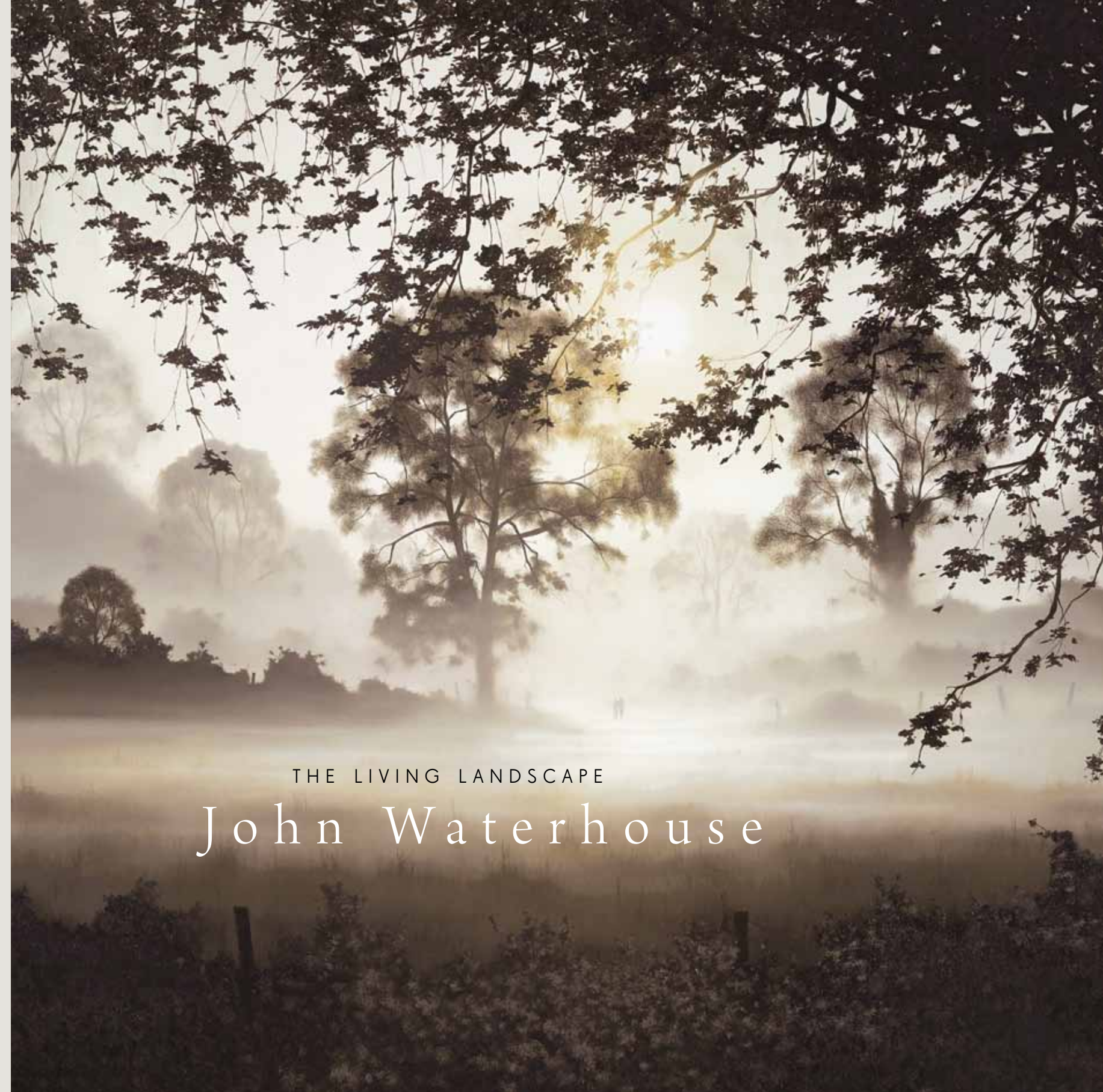

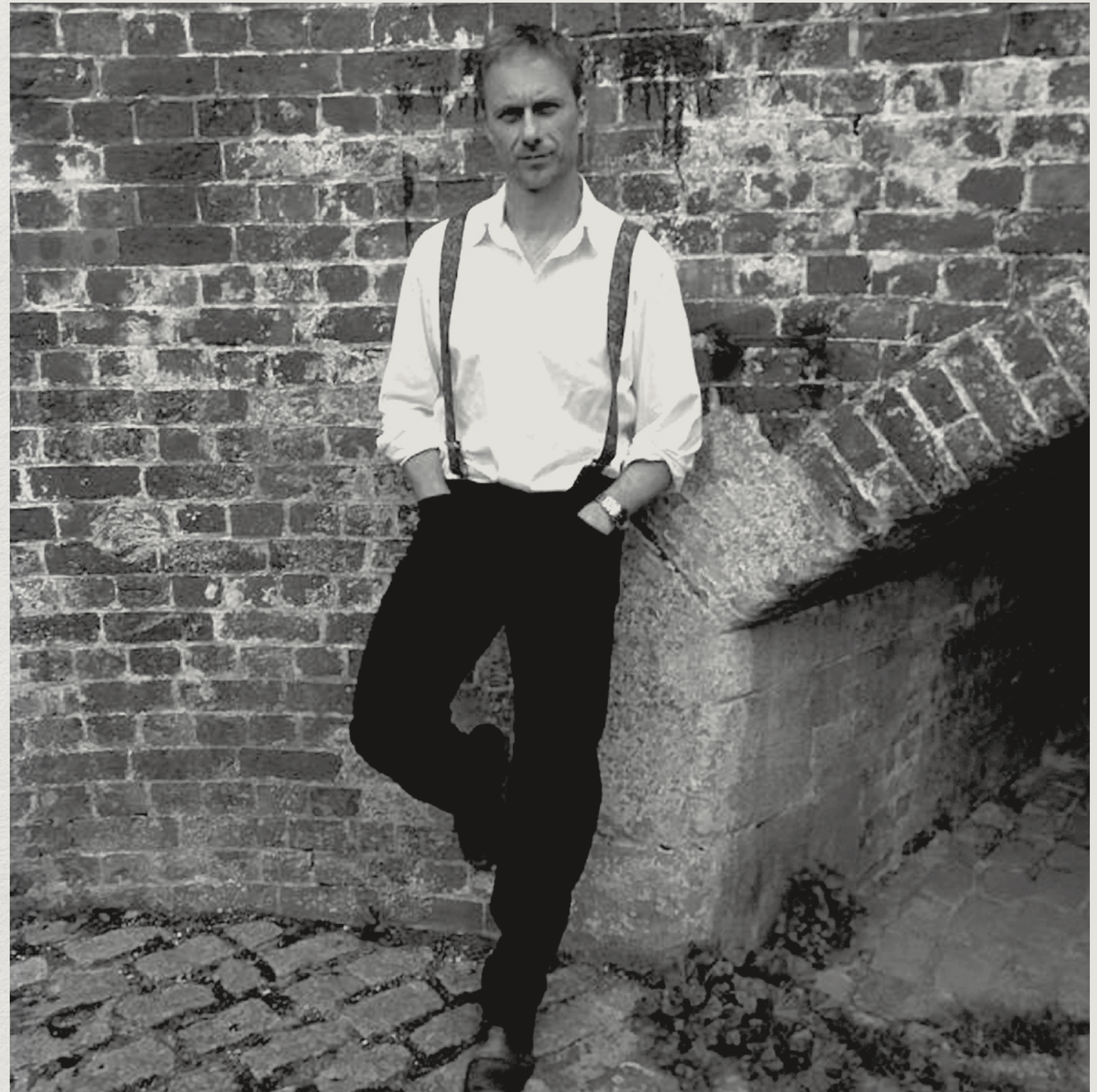


The Way Home
