

Tim applies pastel, charcoal and raw pigment with confidence but also with a remarkable lightness of touch, achieving an extraordinary range of nuance within his distinctive black and white world. By layering the heavier pigments he creates an intense shade of black to contrast with the charcoals he applies with fingers and thumbs.

This 'hands on' process is spontaneous and vigorous, and Tim's fingerprints are, literally, all over his work. While his classical technique is an ever-present grounding force, his intuitive and high-octane creative approach offers a unique take on the animation and vigour of figures in movement, and the compressed energy and life contained within the curves, planes and angles of a building.




